

Regional Representative Role Description

The aim of DTUK is to

1. Raise public awareness on what to do with avulsed teeth
2. Support and advise dentists in the management of all traumatic dental injuries

To support this we will recruit regional representatives from our membership who will provide a network throughout the UK & Northern Ireland to interact with members of the public, other dentists / members of the dental team.

This is an important link to improve education and clinical management and outcomes of traumatic dental injuries.

Regional representatives will

- Be volunteers who will coordinate and support activities locally for the public and the profession
- Be excellent communicators and networkers
- Be committed and enthusiastic ambassadors for Dental trauma UK
- Be committed to education and training
- Be the point of contact with, and provide support to, the local groups in their area
- Be instrumental in improving communication with groups (clinical and non-clinical) to increase the impact of trauma prevention and management in their area
- Be accountable to Dental Trauma UK Board and provide a brief report of activity from time to time
- Work closely with, and be supported by, the Dental Trauma UK Board
- Be invited to attend a CPD accredited workshop where s/he will be provided with a range of materials and information to assist in carrying out the duties of the role

The main responsibilities are to

1. Develop, promote and facilitate educational and training activities locally
2. Provide advice, guidance, support and networking opportunities for members locally
3. Identify and recruit new members
4. Explain clearly the benefits of membership

Period of engagement

The term of office will be 4 years with the possibility of renewal

Remuneration

This is a voluntary position and whilst reasonable expenses incurred whilst undertaking this role may be reimbursed, prior approval will need to be sought. Where possible, the regional reps will be encouraged to tap into existing CPD programmes such as the BDA and LDC's nationally.

- Registered with the General Dental Council
- Be an existing member of Dental trauma UK

- Have experience delivering oral health care in the capacity as a clinical dental technician, dental therapist, dental hygienist, dental nurse, dental technician, dentist
