Beth Burns

Beth qualified in 2004 and undertook Vocational then General Professional Training and Masters in Science prior to entering Specialist training in Restorative Dentistry.

She was appointed as a Consultant in Restorative Dentistry at Glasgow Dental Hospital and School in 2016 and is the lead for development of the Adult Dental Trauma Service in Greater Glasgow and Clyde.

Beth is committed to improving both the immediate and long term management of dental trauma, through education and improved access to appropriate specialist services.

Beth is a Board member of DTUK and their Scottish Lead for Regional Representatives.

Ravi Chauhan

Ravi is a Consultant in Restorative Dentistry at Oxford University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust.

Ravi qualified in 2009 and completed vocational training in Leicester. Following this he undertook Senior House Officer posts in Oral Medicine, Oral Surgery, Paediatric Dentistry, Restorative Dentistry and Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery in Birmingham, Leeds and London.

Ravi was appointed as a Consultant in 2018 following 5 years of specialist training at King's College Hospital. He is now responsible for the restorative care for patients following surgery for head and neck cancer, patients with developmental dental conditions and patients who have suffered dental trauma.

James Darcey

James qualified in 2004 and following vocational training spent 5 years as an associate during which time he was awarded the Diploma of Membership to the Faculty of General Dental Practitioners (MFGDP) in 2006 and, in 2008, a Masters degree in Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery with Distinction from the University of Manchester. In 2010 James began specialist training at the University Dental Hospital of Manchester and attained the Membership in Endodontics from the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh and a Masters in Dental Public Health. He works as a Consultant in Restorative Dentistry at the University Dental Hospital of Manchester where he developed the trauma service for adult patients as well as service general restorative clinics. He continues to work part time in both general & specialist practice and is author of several publications and national awards for his cases and research. He lectures on many aspects of restorative dentistry and, more specifically, trauma and endodontic treatment.



Stephen Henderson

Stephen is a Specialist in Oral Surgery who qualified in London in 1984. After five years in full time hospital practice he went in to general dental practice in Oxford. He continued to work part-time in the Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery Department of the John Radcliffe Hospital until 2000, when he joined Dental Protection. He converted his practice to a largely private referral oral surgery practice when he became a full time adviser at DP in 2007. He continues to work as a visiting specialist in the same practice and at a practice in Bedford. He has undertaken Expert Witness training with Bond Solon.

In December 2017 he left DP and joined MDDUS. In his medico-legal career Stephen's expertise has been complex GDC cases as his medical law degree included a dissertation on Regulatory Law in UK. He has experience of international regulators and the management of dental and maxillofacial claims in a number of different jurisdictions.



Shashi Mishra

Shashi qualified from Glasgow University in 1997 and completed Vocational Training, maxillofacial and dental hospital appointments in Manchester prior to joining the Army. He completed his Masters in Endodontics in 2004 from The UCL Eastman Dental Institute and served as the Endodontic Lead for the Defence Dental Services until leaving the Army in 2010. He now works in private practice in Hitchin, Hertfordshire and is a visiting specialist in practices in Bedford and Cambridge. He is a Regional Rep for DTUK, a MJDF Royal College Examiner and provides endodontic education to experienced Foundation Dentists in the East of England. He is co-founder of EndoArt, a hands-on, 10-day, year-long endodontic training program held in the South East of England which covers dental trauma within its curriculum.
